Spouses and children of permit holders under 18 years of age are required to obtain dependant permits.
- Employers are also required to submit work permit applications to the Immigration Department after they have fulfilled the requirements of the Labour Department.
- Foreign nationals who stay in Brunei Darussalam for a period of more than three months are required to apply for identity cards which are issued by the Immigration Department.

##### c) One Year Visa

Single or Multiple Visit Visa valid for one year can be applied for at Brunei Darussalam's missions abroad or at the Department of Immigration and National Registration.

#### d) Re-entry Visa

Holder of valid Immigration Passes (Visit Pass/Employment Pass/Dependent Pass) can apply for a re-entry visa (single entry or multiple entries) with validity similar to the validity of the immigration pass (maximum one year)
